As the New Year began to unfold, the AZ Legislature's 54th Session kicked off with a challenge from Governor Ducey to bring him a bill to help address Arizona's water issues. He signed the bipartisan supported Arizona's Drought Contingency Plan legislation on January 31st. The Bureau of Reclamation has indicated there are a few other considerations to move it all forward, so they are getting close to an agreement with the Federal officials.

The Arizona Senate confirmed James Goughnour, the Governor's appointment for the Arizona Game & Fish Commission with a unanimous voice vote on the floor on January 29th. Interestingly enough, the Sierra Club tried to stop the appointment in the Senate Natural Resources Committee with a last minute salvo to Democratic Senators resulting in a 4-3 Committee vote along party lines.

The Sierra Club's annual effort to do away with the Commission Appointment Recommendation Board (CARB) is being run by Senator Juan Mendez. SB 1132 would repeal CARB. As a refresher, CARB screens Commission applicants, interviews them, and sends selected candidate recommendations to the Governor for appointment consideration. This is prescribed in Arizona Statute 17-202. For more information click HERE.

AZSFWC has agreed to sponsor legislation eliminating the word and definition of "trophy" from Game & Fish statute language. HB 2433 is sponsored by Rep. Regina Cobb.

AZSFWC is supporting HB 2272 sponsored by Rep. Timothy Dunn in conjunction with the Commission. This legislation would extend residency privileges in big game draws to the youth dependents of active duty service members who qualify as residents of Arizona.

Finally, on our watch list is HB 2547. Rep. Mark Finchem introduced this bill which would "establish the Arizona Department of Public Land Management to provide for public land management by the state." Candidly it's highly unlikely that Congress or the Federal Government is going to yield control over the Federal public land in Arizona to the State, so we'll see where this goes. On the House side there are 25 co-sponsors and on the Senate side, there are 7 cosponsors. Here is a link to the bill language.

At the end of the Session's 19th day, 973 bills were posted, 2 passed, 1 vetoed and 1 signed, with a lot more to come. We'll keep you updated.


