Summarize Project Accomplishments : 9 youths with javelina tags attended and were mentored in hunting javelina Friday through Sunday. Camp activities included sessions lead by volunteers covering topics of hunting safety and ethics, the North American Model of Conservation, firearm safety, tracking and glassing (we brought a taxidermied javelina for them to locate on the hills around camp.) Pointing Dog Club of Arizona brought clay thrower and quail and the kids practiced shooting clays and learned hunting tactics using dogs and hunting quail. Storytelling and Q&A sessions were held every evening after dinner around the campfire. A raffle with various goodies and a .22 rifle was held for all youth participants. Only one javelina was harvested after 1:00 pm on Sunday so we were unable to have a skinning demonstration this year.
