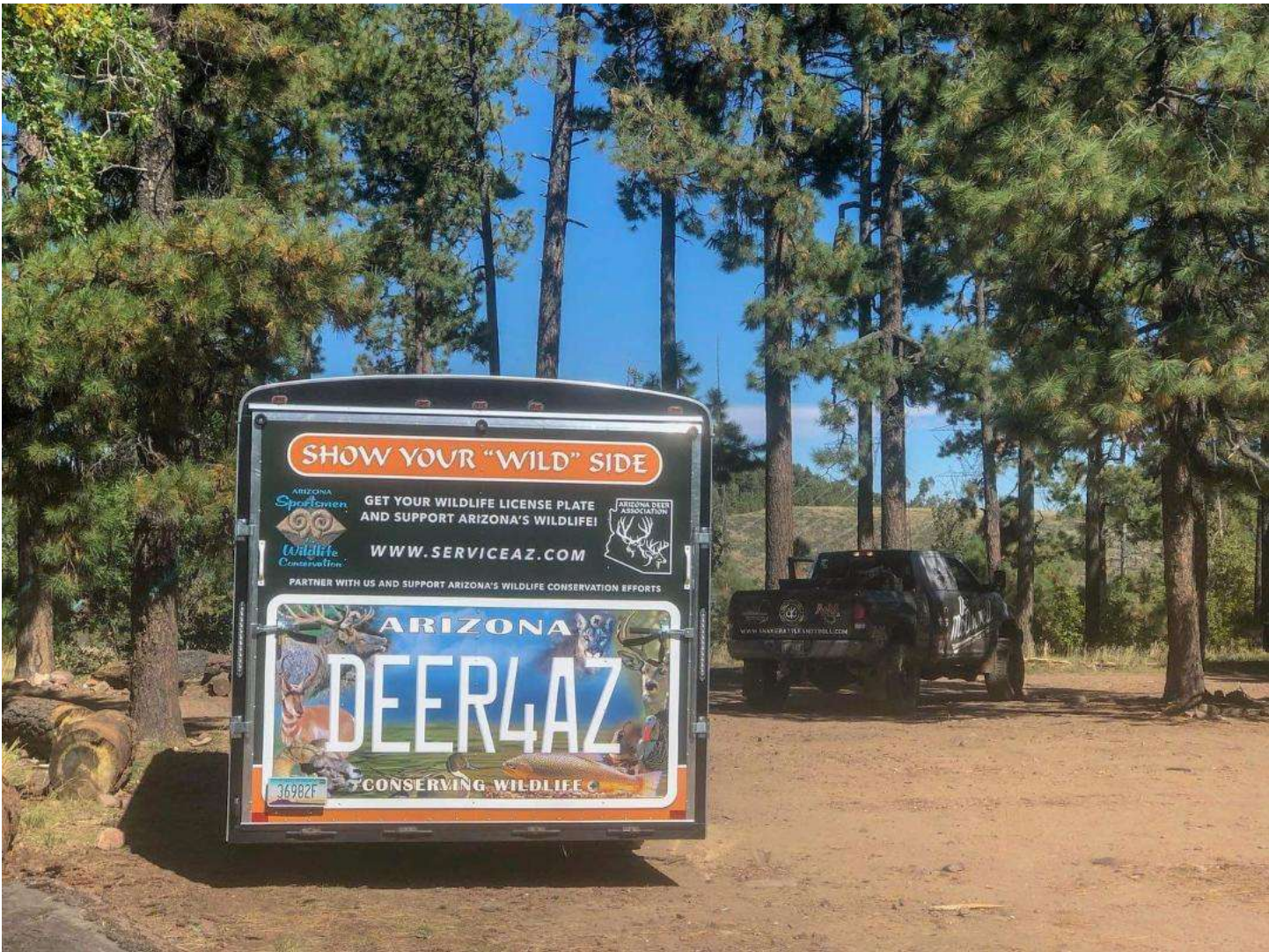

Thanks to the Arizona Sportsmen for Wildlife Conservation, the Arizona Deer Association was able to purchase, customize, and wrap a much-needed new trailer for our ever-growing Annual Deer/Elk Youth Camp. The trailer was finished just in time for this year's camp in October. As such, we were able to haul everything needed to supply the 4-day event with food, seating, shade, and full cooking/registration stations for 60 registered youth hunters and their families. Not only was the trailer vital in supporting the success of this Youth Camp, which supports the education of future hunters, but will be key to ensuring the sustainability of Youth Camps and Wildlife Habitat Projects in the future.
