Summarize Project Accomplishments: The Arizona Deer Association acquired the water wagon and trailer set-up in November 2020, although we were still purchasing accessories and operating equipment as late as March 2021. From November until present day, we have used it to haul 40,000 gallons of water to wildlife catchments and tanks in GMU 22 Bar X Ranch, and five other locations and in GMU 23, Brown Ranch, Allotment H4, and multiple other locations. These water catchments benefit not only deer, but also small game species and birds, mountain lions, bear, javelina, etc.
