Summarize Project Accomplishments :

We held two one-week sessions. Participants learned the basics of fly and spin cast fishing, including an overview of the equipment, knots and casting techniques, fly tying, fish anatomy, dissection and pathology, entomology, including using a seine to capture aquatic invertebrates, aquatic invasive, nuisance species, water and soil conservation, including 'leave no trace' philosophy. Also had daily excursions to other mountain lakes, an introduction and understanding of AZGFD rules and regulations for fishing and taking of aquatic species, how to properly catch, clean, and cook a fish. One day was spent fishing and canoe fishing at Woods Canyon Lake, followed by a tour of the AZGFD Canyon Creek Fish Hatchery

The group learned a lot from the "socially-distanced" hands-on instructions, which resulted in them catching enough fish for a fish fry on one evening. They also cleaned their own fish, learned about fish anatomy and how to prepare and cook them for dinner.

Some of the highlights included keynote address by AZGFD Commissioner James Goughnour and AZTU Chair Steve Reiter setting the stage for the week-long program that will help to create the next generation of conservationists.

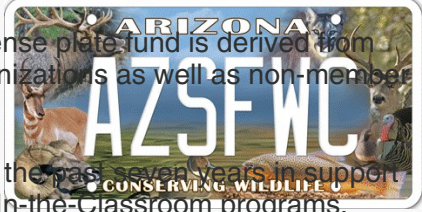
