Enclosed please find the completion report for Az Sportsman for Wildlife Conservation regarding the Black Mountain Tank Project in Unit 7E north of Flagstaff.

The project was completed with help from the Mule Deer Foundation (Northern Arizona Chapter) volunteers from the Friends of Northern Arizona Forests as well as Colby Walton the WM for unit 7.

In particular the Friends of Northern Arizona Forests under the direction of Tom Mackin and Bruce Belman are invaluable in helping with the various projects. Like the mule Deer foundation, they are a nonprofit but work with the Forest Service primarily on the Coconino National Forest on projects that the Forest Service does not have the time or manpower to complete.

Many of these projects like the Black Mountain Tank rebuild could not be completed without the help and dedication of Tom, Bruce, and their bunch of volunteers. Their expertise, knowledge, and experience in having build so many of these tanks makes each job go smooth and with few if any hiccups greatly reducing the time and effort needed to complete the project.

The Black Mountain Tank Project was begun on April 23rd and finished the next day on Saturday the 24th. In all some 18 or 19 volunteers worked on the projects and as mentioned included members of MDF, FoNAF, Coconino Sportsman and the Arizona Game and Fish Department. We are especially grateful to the AZ Sportsman for Wildlife Conservation in helping fund this project by enabling us to purchase the frame and materials and hardware necessary to compete the project.

This area of the State is very prone to drought conditions and the completion of this project will enable all wildlife in the area to have a dependable water source and will help alleviate the need to haul water to the area on a continual basis.

Once again, we thank the AZSWC and look forward to working with the group on similar projects in the months and years to come.
