Our great partners from AZ G&F, Huachuca Gould's Chapter of NWTf and the Southern AZ German Shorthair Club made this event look easy. We increased our capacity this year by adding a second dog field and trap station. We also added two new events with an exciting working dog demo from Pima County Sheriff's Department and a raptor display from the Arizona Falconers Association. We had the largest number of participants and volunteers ever for this event. We were able to provide all the youth participants a hat and a shirt and everyone got breakfast and lunch, all at no cost to individuals. We were able to support this with grants from Arizona Sportsman for Wildlife Conservation and Justin Corbet Memorial Shooting Sports Foundation plus a generous donation from the Robert D.
