Summarize Project Accomplishments:

51 new students completed NRA Shotgun Basics instruction and NRA certifications for their development of safe shooting skills and training in clay target sports (skeet, trap and sporting clays) which enables these new shotgun shooters to not only know the sports, but have the personal capabilities to compete in shotgun sports leagues, tournaments, and upland bird hunting. The students in these programs represented all segments of the R3: Recruitment into the shotgun sports; Retention in shooting shotguns; and Reactivation of those who had shotguns, but did not know the shotgun sports or may have been a clay target shooter in earlier days but never participated in a different clay target sport. Others may have a shotgun for dove hunting, but never knew how to safely handle a shotgun, nor had a clue as the rules and etiquette of a specific clay target sport.

Two of the male youths will be enrolled in the Scholastic Clay Target Program in the Fall of 2023, continuing development of their shooting skills for local and national competitions. Several of the adult participants (with their newly gained confidence) are now shooting in the bi-monthly sporting clays Fun Shoots at Ben Avery Clay Target Center, and this demonstrates how these programs developed their passion for the clay target sports, because these shoots have been conducted in summer heat. One male youth has been introduced to dove hunting through a coach of this program.

Because of this program, we were also able to get three new volunteers certified as coaches by the National Shooting Sports Foundation. This accomplishment contributes not only to the continuity of this program, but also provides valuable resources and assistance for VOTSQF (Valley of the Sun Quail Forever) future women and youth outdoors hunting events.

Last, but not least, a most important accomplishment was being able to continue this program despite adversity. With the dissolution of Ben Avery Clay Busters beginning in the Fall of 2022, the Cactus Wren founders (Marci and Larry Welton) were able to keep the beginners' shotgun program intact through VOTSQF and the Arizona State Rifle & Pistol

Association Shotgun Division. These beginners' programs began in 2010 through an evolution of programs in partnership with Ben Avery Clay Target Center. It remains key to the recruitment of new shooters and future hunters.
