Dear AZSFWC Committee,

Thank you for your support and for helping make our recent efforts a great success. We are continuing to invest in the lives of these boys, who have now completed their hunter's education and are mastering small game hunting. Our next step is preparing them for big game hunting, which is incredibly exciting for them.

As I look ahead to the upcoming season, I'm planning several guided hunts with the boys and would greatly appreciate AZSFWC's continued support. However, I'm unsure if I have the capacity to fully engage with the application process at this time. As of now, I am a one-man operation, balancing the demands of a full-time pastorate, managing a growing staff, and overseeing a multi-million dollar operation. AZ Quail Today is a very small operation which has been funded largely through my own contributions, along with the help of a few key partners.

While I may not be as skilled in handling the detailed aspects of the application, follow-up, and reporting requirements, I am deeply committed to this work. I would welcome any feedback on how our efforts have been perceived and would be open to exploring ways to continue partnering with you in the future—perhaps in a way that might reduce some of the paperwork burden. As of now, I simply don't have the time to dedicate to the full application process, but I remain hopeful that circumstances may change.
