The original trailer estimate was for a metal tank for the water. It was going to take too long to have it built and we decided on this trailer as a more cost effective option.


We installed a Predator water pump from WWW stock, instead of purchasing a new one. It is one of the cheapest water pumps out there, and it didn't make sense to buy another when we had functional ones in stock. We will keep this pump functional for the life of the trailer. We gave a advertised price for the Predator pump. \$289, which is a fairly cost effective pump (Harbor Freight).

The receipt (\$265.22) for pump hose and connectors is from WWW business credit card statement as we lost the store receipt.
