The Arizona Council of Trout Unlimited and chapters continue to have a supply of volunteers to contribute time, contributions and expenses for travel, monitoring and coordinating the various activities with the 36 registered schools and AZGFD.

Normal delivery and set-up time for new schools was approximately 6 hours per tank and annual hours per volunteer supporting a teacher now range from 10 - 20 hours depending upon the teacher's experience and the additional time spent by volunteers for problem solving, classroom lectures, class projects and potential field trips.

Acknowledgment of Arizona Sportsmen For Wildlife Conservation (AZSFWC) and the Conservation License Plate Program has been recognized throughout the past years on chapter websites, at TIC training sessions, slide presentations, announcements, in AZTU Council and chapter newsletters and meetings, in classroom literature, the annual Native and Wild Trout Conference and other opportunities. An AZSFWC decal has been provided to each school for display on the classroom aquarium. Recognition of supporters has also been provided to schools, parents, the educational community and communities throughout Arizona. Examples of recognition are attached.

## What is Trout in the Classroom?

Trout in the Classroom (TIC) is a program that offers students a chance to raise trout in a classroom setting. The environmental education program provides students in grades 4 - 12 hands-on experience in:

- raising trout from eggs to fry
- monitoring tank water quality
- engaging in stream habitat studies
- learning to appreciate water resources
- beginning to foster a conservation ethic
- growing an understanding of ecosystems

Each teacher can tailor the program to fit their needs during the school year. Each program is unique and has interdisciplinary applications for STREAM (Science, Technology, Recreation, Engineering, Art and Math) which can support mandated education requirements.

## TIC is for Most Grade Levels

Teachers in any classroom can make TIC relevant to their classroom curriculum. In the early grades, the focus can be on caring, growth, understanding life cycles and the seasons. A high school program might explore water chemistry, the nitrogen cycle, natural resource management, watershed geology and ecology.

## Why Participate in TIC?

Because TIC brings nature into the classroom, it allows students to develop a personal bond with the natural world and a sense of conservation ethics at the core of Trout Unlimited's mission ([www.tu.org](http://www.tu.org)). Youth and young anglers better understand the value of their local waters and fisheries when they have seen the trout life cycle up close and personal in this way.

## TIC Across the Country

TIC volunteers, teachers and students across the U.S. share resources and learn from one another. For this reason, Trout Unlimited staff and volunteers in 35 states participate in more than 5,000 classroom programs in the United States. ## TIC in Arizona

The Arizona TIC Program has grown over the past years. In 2014 there were 3 schools with an increase to 36 schools for the 2024 - 2025 school year.

This expansion has been due to the cooperation of Trout Unlimited, the Arizona Game and Fish Department and large grants provided by the Arizona Sportsmen for Wildlife Conservation (AZSFWC) License Plate Program and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Partners for Fish and Wildlife Program.

Trout Unlimited provides the equipment setup and annual supplies to eligible schools for free.

As a result of this year's supporting grants, student involvement and experiences will again be for over 5,000 students. An additional 10,000 people will connect with the program through visits by parents, relatives, school administrators and classroom guests.
