Measurable Results (Fill in all that are applicable):

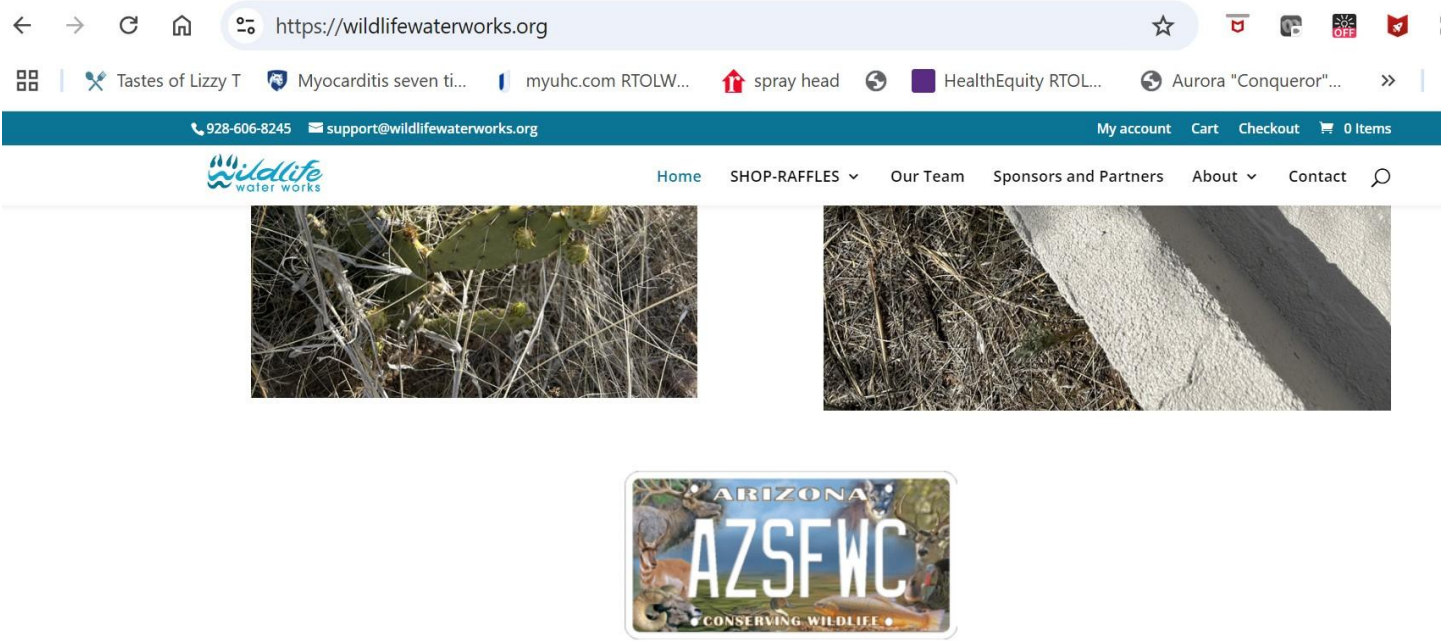
This is a very reliable water trailer that we modified to haul water in a rough environment. Plumbing and tools boxes were added. We installed a Predator water pump from WWW stock, instead of purchasing a new one. It is one of the cheapest water pumps out there, and it didn't make sense to buy another when we had functional ones in stock. We will keep this pump functional for the life of the trailer. We gave a advertised price for the Predator pump. \$289, which is a fairly cost effective pump (Harbor Freight).

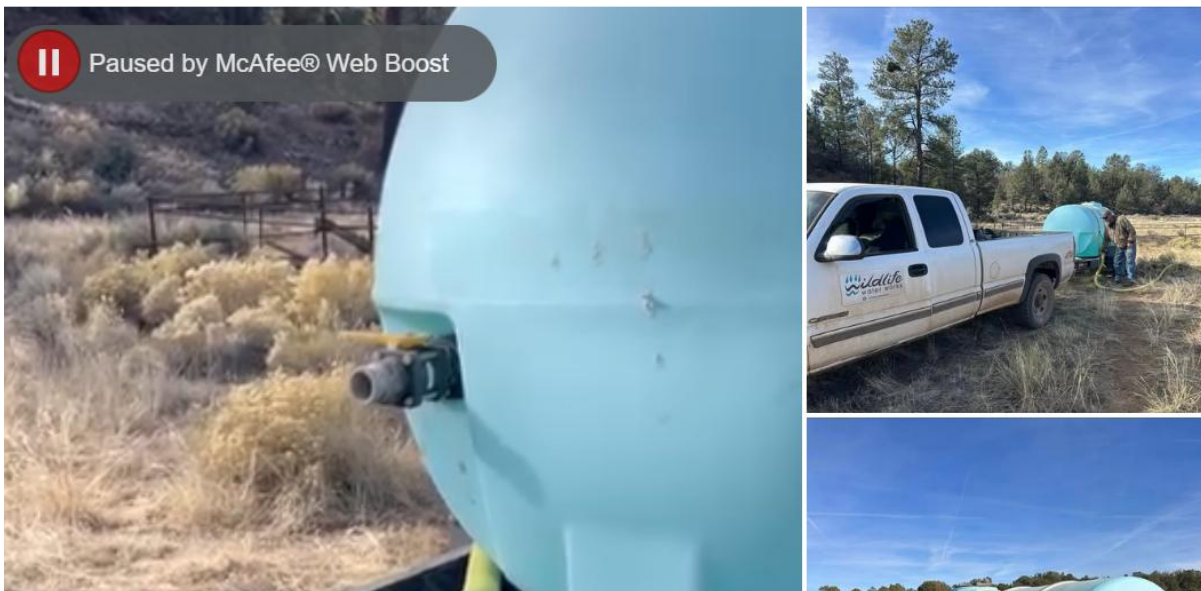
