## **Summarize Project Accomplishments :**

The purpose of this project is to convert a well to a solar array system for the Ox Yoke Ranch LLC, owned by Jesse White. The well houses a 40,000 gallon storage tank that supplies water to eight different tire drinkers. The well is operated by a generator and is constantly fueled to pump water to each drinker. The Arizona Sportsmen for Wildlife Conservation donated \$6,000 and Arizona Antelope Foundation donated \$3,000. The money was used to purchase 15 solar panels, a pipe structure frame for the panels, and a control board. Jesse White also gave \$3,000 for the project. The project was completed at the end of November 2022. Pronghorn is the primary beneficiary to this water project. This project will provide year round water and increase water availability/distribution in northern Game Management 4B.
