Summarize Project Accomplishments: 23 kids attended, 17 with Javelina tags. We had 14 mentors and 6 Game and Fish wildlife managers. 2 javelina and 1 coyote were harvested this year. Harvests seem to fluctuate alternate years, last year 8 were harvested out of 11 tags. Workshops and demos were held daily and all participants encouraged to bring a friend next year. Quail and Point dog club were absent this year so we are returning the funds designated for the clays and quail.
