They were able to learn fishing skills with the help of the High School Fishing Club where kids were able to catch catfish that were in large stock tanks that were donated by the Arizona Game and Fish Department , lure painting operated by Home Depot, firearm safety and target practice (with BB Guns) in an inflatable bb gun range donated by Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation and operated by Yuma Police Department, and how to safely handle and shoot a bow and arrow operated by Southwest Bowhunters, This year we added varmint calling that was operated by Phoenix Varmint Callers, Being and Outdoor Woman (BOW) was on site to educate women that were interested in the outdoors, Sportsman's Warehouse operated our Optics tent where the kids learned how to operate and find the critter silhouettes we placed in the surrounding hills. This Clinic displayed outdoor activities not to just Youth but also to their Parents. This event has been growing in leaps and bounds, we started with 50 children a few years ago, in 2007 we had over 300 children, in 2018 we had over 500 children and in 2019 we had 864 registered kids. We had 60 plus volunteers that were able to help organize and run this event.

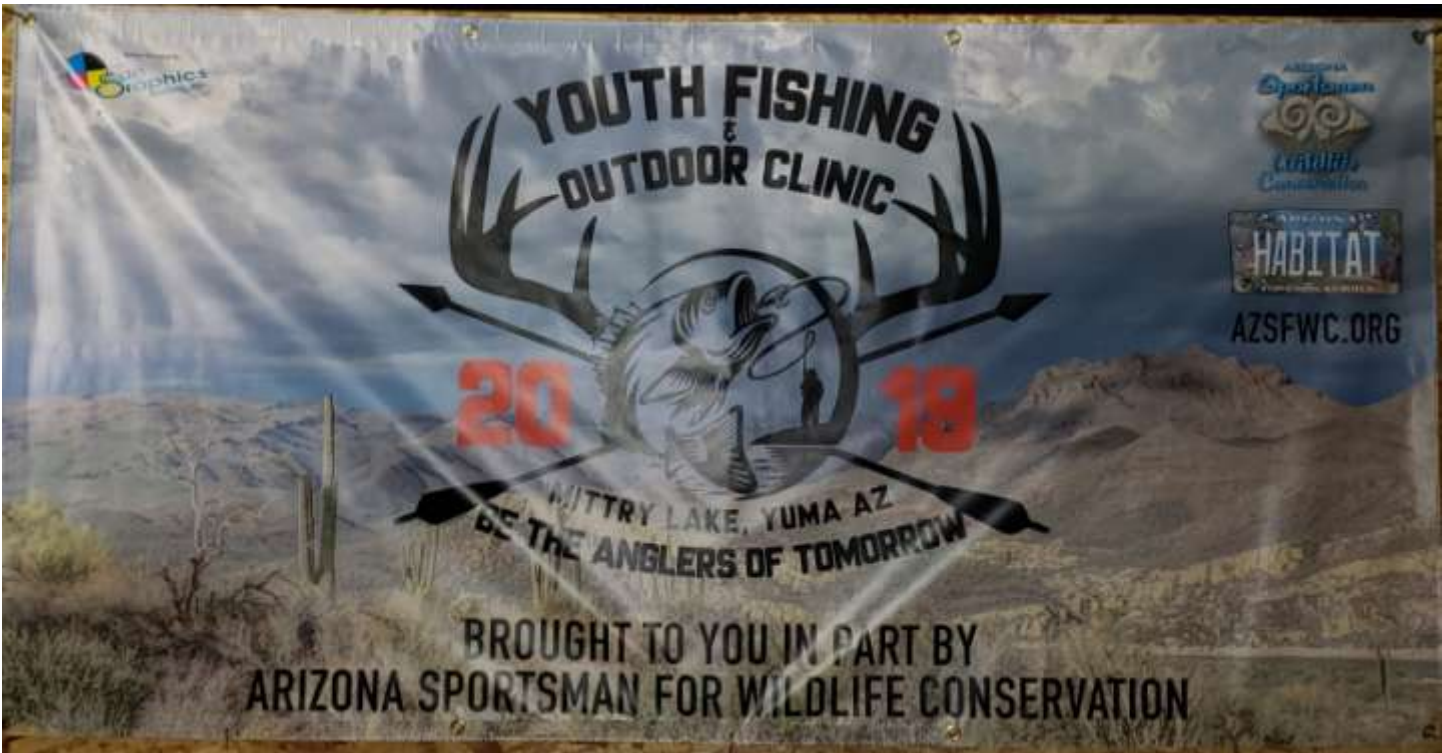
